

MSBA Park Directions

Major and Minor PeeWee

- 1. Tom Chater:** From the 401 – Take the Winston Churchill Exit and proceed south. Two lights past the 403 turn right on The Collegeway. Park is on the north side between Winston Churchill and Colonial Drive.
- 2. Tom Chater:** From the QEW – Take the Winston Churchill exit North to the Collegeway. Turn Left and the park is on the north side between Winston Churchill and Colonial Drive
- 3. South Common:** From the 401 – Take the Winston Churchill exit south to Burnhamthorpe Road. Turn left and proceed to Glen Erin. The park is situated behind Loyola Ignatius Church on the corner of Burnhamthorpe and Glen Erin.
- 4. South Common:** From the QEW – Take the Winston Churchill exit North to Burnhamthorpe Road. Turn right and proceed to Glen Erin. The park is situated behind Loyola Ignatius Church on the corner of Burnhamthorpe and Glen
- 5. Garthwood-** From the 401 - Go to Winston churchill south to The Collegeway. Go west to Clayton, turn Left to the end which is Garthwood Park
- 6. Thorncrest Park:** - From the 401 Please go to Winston Churchill south to Burnhamthorpe. Go west to Colonial and turn right. The park is on your right hand side about 100 yards north of Burnhamthorpe
- 7. White Oaks:-**From the QEW Southdown Road (Erin Mills Parkway) south to Truscott. East on Truscott past Clarkson Road. Look for Lorne Park Library and/or Lorne Park SS on the south side. Parking is usually available at those locations. There is a pathway behind the library to the park, which is surrounded by a large stand of white oak trees. Watch for poison ivy.
- 8. Q Park.** 401 east or west to Erin Mills Parkway. South to Erin Centre Drive. West to the park across from the Erin Mills Town centre. QEW east or west to Erin Mills Parkway. North to Erin Centre Drive. West to the diamond across from the Erin Mills Town Centre.
- 9. Birchwood Parks:** QEW east or west to Southdown Road. South to Lakeshore Road. East to Clarkson Road. North to the park on the east side about 200 yards north of the Lakeshore.
